Attend the Homeowner Maintenance of Systems Course for Free!

The 2 hour course in Lockhart provides a basic understanding of the operational and maintenance activities of conventional and aerobic septic systems, and explains how activities within the home impact septic systems. Presentations will cover the treatment processes, health and safety considerations, and an overview of how to inspect and maintain the system. This course also provides answers to the most frequently asked septic system questions, including when to pump out a tank and what can or cannot go down the drain. The 6 hour courses in Kyle and San Marcos cover the same material as the 2 hour class, but go more in depth on aerobic systems and their operation and maintenance.
